



## 2019 CMiC-Allen Berg Memorial Scholarship National Competition Results

Twenty-five (25) students from 19 states have won CMiC-Allen Berg Memorial Scholarships, worth between \$10,000 and \$40,000. A total of \$400,000 was awarded.

Forty-four (44) ACE affiliates nominated a student for the scholarship. Applications were reviewed first by a team composed of ACE Board members. Several members of the ACE Executive Committee then made final selections.

Selected on the basis of merit and financial need, scholarship winners this fall will enter accredited college programs in architecture, interior design and several engineering fields, including civil, mechanical, electrical, and architectural. Half of scholarship recipients are minority, and more than two-thirds are female.
