Eligibility Requirements

- » High school senior currently participating in ACE Greater Akron-Canton
- » Minimum of 75% attendance and active participation in the ACE program
- Plans to enroll in a fulltime undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or fouryear public or non-profit college, university, vocational school or plans to enter an apprenticeship trade program



Application Requirements

- Complete the ACE Mentor Program Scholarship Application
- » High School Transcript
- » Two recommendation letters are required (at least one from ACE mentor and one from an outside source)

Plan ahead and ask your mentors early for a recommendation letter!



Obligations

- » Scholarship recipient must complete the Scholarship Terms Document
- » Scholarships are renewable for four years based on maintenance of full-time status
- » Students can apply for alumni scholarships
- » Scholarship recipients will be asked to return and participate in future ACE related activities
- » Students must register as alumni
